The Chairman wished councillors season's greetings and reminded them that this was the last meeting until February 2014.

## 7. Set Precept 2014/2015

The clerk recommended that the precept should rise in line with the September reported RPI of 2.6%. Councillors voted to accept the recommendation (one against). The average band D charge will change from £37.71 to £38.73.

SKDC have advised that the Local Tax Support (LTS) grant of £1121 will be maintained for 2014/2015 financial year. However this cannot be guaranteed for subsequent years and parishes will have to budget for it unless there is a change in central government policy. The National Association for Local Councils is in consultation with the government.

#### 8. Clerk's Report

- a) Spring Lane. Work by LCC Highways (footpaths) to improve the footpath has been completed (High Street to School Lane.
- b) St John's Baptist church wall has been rebuilt, capping yet to be replaced.
- c) Water Lane, Colsterworth. LCC Highways have completed the resurfacing work.
- d) Old Railway land. Safety railing has been erected at the east end abutment.
- e) North Witham. Speed limits. LCC Highways Manager Kevin Brumfield has advised that there has been no change in the policy at the moment. However he advises that:

"The task and finish group will be meeting shortly and hopefully they will make recommendations which should possibly see the speed limit introduced but obviously I cannot guarantee this. The members and officers are all aware of residents' feelings from villages which do not meet the minimum standard and I am sure they will take this into account when making their decision."

f) LCC Highways. The clerk has reminded Highways that the following roads require attention and requested them to make financial provision in 2014/2015:

Rectory Lane, North Witham; Water Lane, Stainby; Old Post Lane, Woolsthorpe Road, Back Lane, Bourne Road Estate.

- g) Derelict garage. SKDC have provided advice in this matter however it is still hoped that this issue can be resolved amicably.
- h) Sir Isaac Newton Village Hall. A request for a grant towards the cost of new lighting has been received. A grant of £250 was agreed (one against) but subject to perusal of the VH annual accounts. Final decision will be made at the next PC meeting.

## 9. Neighbourhood Plan

The committee has been formed. Next meeting will be Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December 7pm at the White Lion.
